Thank you for taking the time to review the role of Staff Nurse with the Muiríosa Foundation. This document provides additional information to candidates in relation to the role.

1. How do I apply for this post?

- **Applications are online through the Muiríosa Foundation Website recruitment page [Current Vacancies](#)**
- You are requested to upload your CV, which should outline your education and career history and other relevant information which should include your mobile phone number.
- You will be asked to respond to a small number of questions on the online system.
- Only applications received before the closing date and time will be considered.
- Proposed interview dates will be indicated at a later stage.
- All contact with candidates will mainly be through email, therefore you must ensure that your email address is entered to the system correctly.

2. Selection Process

- Initially a shortlisting process will be undertaken by the selection panel, after which each candidate will be informed of the outcome.
- When a candidate is shortlisted they will be invited to interview.

3. Location

You will initially be required to work in our Laois Services but from time to time you may be required to work at other venues within the Muiríosa Foundation.

4. Pay Scale
