

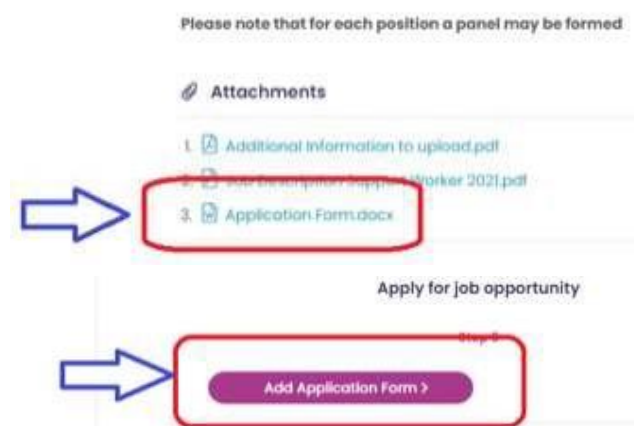
Additional Information

Thank you for taking the time to review the role of Social Care Worker with the Muiríosá Foundation.

This document provides additional information to candidates in relation to the role.

1. How do I apply for this post?

- **Applications are online through the Muiríosá Foundation Website recruitment page [Current Vacancies](#)**
- Initially you will be asked to respond to a small number of questions on the online system.
- You are requested to upload your application form, which should outline your education and career history and other relevant information. You can download the application form which is available as an attachment to the advertisement. Click on the Application form attachment as shown below:



- When you have completed the Application form save it to your system.
- You can then upload your completed Application form during the online application process. Click on 'Add Application Form' shown above.
- Only applications received before the closing date and time will be considered.
- Proposed interview dates will be indicated at a later stage.
- All contact with candidates will mainly be through email, therefore you must ensure that your email address is entered to the system correctly.
- Some contact may be by mobile phone and you must ensure to provide a valid mobile number requested in the online questions

2. Selection Process

- Initially a shortlisting process will be undertaken by the selection panel, after which each candidate will be informed of the outcome.
- When a candidate is shortlisted they will be invited to interview.

3. Additional Information

Please note that due to the current Covid-19 Pandemic interviews may be carried out online using the Microsoft Teams – candidates will be informed closer to interview date.

4. Location

You will initially be required to work in the Longford/ Westmeath Services but from time to time you may be required to work at other venues within the Muiríosá Foundation.
